Admission for M.Sc MLT Course

(Affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University Health Sciences, Karnataka)

ALHS offers Master of Science in Medical Laboratory Technology course in

the following two specialties:

- a. **M.Sc Medical Laboratory Technology- Microbiology & Immunology**
- b. **M.Sc Medical Laboratory Technology- Haematology & Blood transfusion**

The course shall include hands on training in the clinical area.

A candidate seeking admission to the Masters of Science in Medical Laboratory Technology course shall have passed B. Sc MLT course from Institution affiliated to RGUHS. Students who have passed B. Sc MLT course from other universities considered equivalent by RGUHS are also eligible for this course.

DURATION OF THE COURSE: M.SC DEGREE

shall be for a period of 2 years.

Note: No candidate shall be admitted for the post graduate Degree course unless the candidate has obtained and produced the eligibility certificate issued by the University.



Admission for B.Sc Courses

(Affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University Health Sciences, Karnataka)

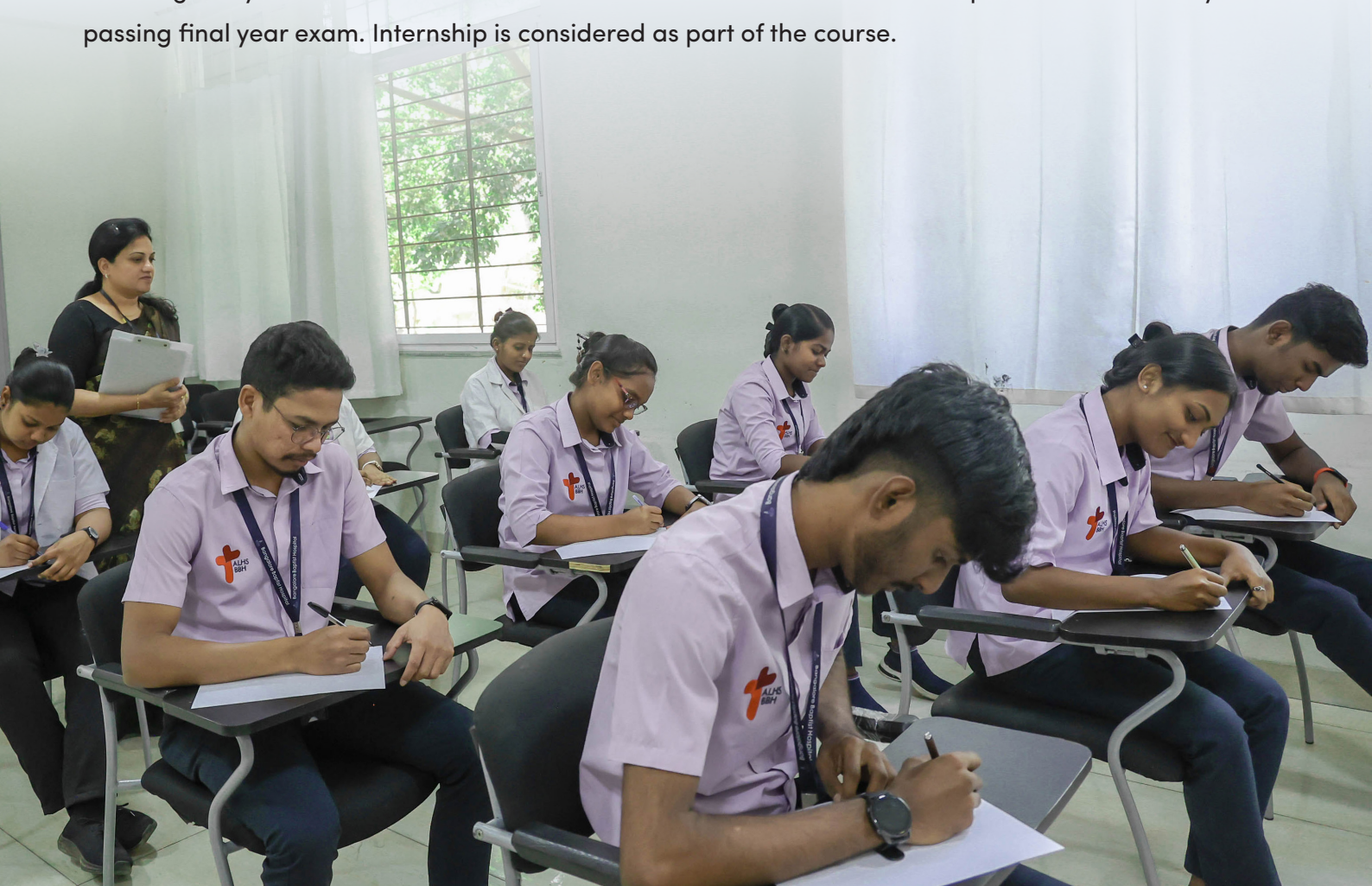
Applications are invited for the following UG courses and a candidate seeking admission to the Bachelor of Science Degree Course shall have passed PUC/12th or its equivalent (pre-university / pre-degree / intermediate) examination from any recognized Board or University in India as recognized by RGUHS, with the following (mandatory) combination of subjects:

Degree Courses	Combinations of Subjects Required
B.Sc Medical Laboratory Technology	English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology
B.Sc Medical Imaging Technology	English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology
B.Sc Anaesthesia and OT Technology	English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology
B.Sc Radiotherapy	English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics
B.Sc Cardiac Care Technology	English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology
B.Sc Emergency and Trauma Care Technology	English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology

The vocational higher secondary education course conducted by Vocational Higher Secondary Education, Government of Kerala with five subjects including Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in addition to vocational subjects is considered equivalent to PU examinations of Government of Karnataka Pre University Course.

DURATION OF THE COURSE: B.SC DEGREE shall be for a period of 4 years

including one year of **COMPULSORY INTERNSHIP IN THE HOSPITAL**. Internship will start only after passing final year exam. Internship is considered as part of the course.





Admission for Diploma Courses

The Standard of admission to the course is in accordance with the requirements of Karnataka Paramedical Board. The medium of instruction is English.

Eligibility Requirements

A. Minimum Qualification for 2 years Diploma Course plus 3 months of COMPULSORY INTERNSHIP IN THE HOSPITAL

Candidates seeking admission must have passed PUC/12th or its equivalent (pre- university/pre-degree/ intermediate) examination from any recognized Board or University in India, with the following (mandatory) combination of Subjects:

Basic Diploma Course – 2 years	Combination of subjects required
Medical Laboratory Technology	Physics, Chemistry, Biology
Medical Imaging Technology	Physics, Chemistry, Biology
Anaesthesia & Operation Theater Technology	Physics, Chemistry, Biology
Ophthalmic Technology	Physics, Chemistry, Biology
Medical Records Technology	Any Discipline (Science /Arts /Commerce) with English (Science preferred) / English type writing (Jr/Sr) and Computer Knowledge are desirable

B. Minimum Qualification for 3 years Diploma Course plus 3 months of COMPULSORY INTERNSHIP IN THE HOSPITAL.

The candidate should have passed SSLC or its equivalent examination from a recognized Board in India.

Application Procedure

- Application can be collected from ALHS office by paying Rs. 500/- in cash counter
- Alternatively application can be downloaded from the website and the duly filled application form along with the Rs. 500/- DD in favour of Bangalore Baptist Hospital with hard copies of documents listed should reach The Principal, Allied Health Training Bangalore Baptist Hospital Bellary Road, Hebbal, Bengaluru – 560024, before 15th June 2024.
- Read the eligibility criteria carefully before selecting the courses.
- The application fee will not be refunded under any circumstance.
- All the information given in the application form should be correct. Any false information or suppression of any factual information in the application would be disqualified. If such an event comes to notice during the course, he/she would be liable to be terminated besides other actions by the institution, as may be deemed fit.

Note:

- Short listed candidates are required to carry the above documents in original for the interview.
- Any changes in the date etc, will be updated on the website
- Separate applications are available for M.Sc, B.Sc and Diploma courses.



Method of Selection

- Candidates when required to appear for the interview/test shall do so at their own expense.
- The written Entrance test will comprise of questions in General Knowledge, General Science, Mathematics and English. The list of candidates selected for the interview shall be displayed on the notice board.
- A personal interview for selected candidates will be conducted by the selection committee.
- The candidates are required to bring all the Certificates, testimonials and other documents in Original (as per list of enclosures) for verification during the interview & the same shall be submitted once the candidate is selected. Laminated certificates will not be accepted.
- The students must retain sufficient number of photocopies of the submitted originals.
- Submission of fake certificates (including color Xerox copies) is punishable and may attract penalty of Rs 10000/- or above and admission will stand cancelled. Institution shall not be liable, and the candidate will be held fully responsible in this matter.
- Selection of candidates is purely by merit and subject to medical fitness as certified by the staff doctor of Bangalore Baptist Hospital.
- Sponsorship does not guarantee admission.
- The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final. Unsolicited correspondence will not be considered.

Medium of Instruction:

The medium of instruction and examination shall be in English.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

There shall be annual examinations, one at the end of each year conducted by the University/ Board. Annual Exam in September, Supplementary Exam in March. Three internal exams will be held in the college in a year.



Extra Curricular Activities

Activities such as Cultural programmes, Sports and other Competitions are arranged every year. Students are encouraged to actively participate in them.

Withdrawal from the Course

If a student withdraws from the training program within 15 days from the date of admission (Payment of fees), one -third of the total amount will be forfeited.

Beyond 15 days of time, the entire amount paid will be forfeited.

Students who discontinue from the course beyond 60 days shall be required to pay the full fees for all the years of duration of course and an additional sum of Rs. 25,000/- to Bangalore Baptist Hospital, since discontinuation constitutes wastage of a valuable seat and also of subsidized education availed of till then.

Fees already paid will not be refunded.

A student who is dismissed from the course due to unsatisfactory conduct or low standard of work shall not be eligible for any refund of fees.

Accommodation and Mess

Advance fees for Hostel accommodation for the year needs to be paid, when availed. Accommodation is subject to availability and the rooms are allotted annually. A request for accommodation needs to be made annually by interested students.

Students can avail food in the hospital canteen at the prevailing rates.

If a student avails the hostel facility he/she shall automatically be signed into the mess run by the hospital canteen and shall also strictly abide by the rules of the hospital and hostel.

Value Education

Students have various opportunities for personality development, communication skills and imbibing values.

Students have prayer everyday and a common chapel service on Friday.

Medical Care

Students shall undergo a medical check up on admission to the course. It is mandatory that the students are immunised for Hepatitis B. Medical care is available in the hospital during illness, and the cost is to be borne by the student

General Rules For Students

A. Uniform

Selected candidates must buy the prescribed uniform

In addition, RGUHS students should have a white apron (coat), and Paramedical Board students should have a white apron with blue collar and the initials PMS stitched on the sleeves.

Operation theatre students will have to get additional 2 sets of OT scrub dresses with their names.

Students are required to wear formal black shoes in the hospital. When in uniform, students are not permitted to wear any form of jewelry, bracelets or nail polish except small earstuds.

Hair must be tidy, kept short (boys) and combed back.

B. Student's Discipline

All students are expected to maintain discipline and high standards of moral character, especially in view of the fact that the course is conducted in a hospital setting.

The Allied health program is co-educational and students are expected to behave appropriately. Students are expected to follow the rules and regulations of the institution and the hostel.

Students are expected to follow the rules of their departments, and behave in a manner befitting a professional when on the hospital premises.

Students are subjected to disciplinary action as per rules of the hospital.

A first offence would attract a fine (either by itself or coupled with warning memo / suspension from the course) and a second or repeated offence would attract dismissal, unless an offence by its very nature is so serious that it warrants dismissal in the first instance.

Use of the mobile phone is strictly prohibited within college campus or while in patient care areas.

Uploading objectionable photos/video on social media is strictly prohibited.

C. Attendance & Leave Rules

Every candidate should have attendance of at least 80% of the total number of classes conducted in an academic year from the date of commencement of the term to the last working day as notified by University / Board in each of the subjects prescribed for that year separately in theory and practical.

Only such candidates are eligible to appear for the University/Board examinations in their first attempt.

The students shall be entitled to the national holidays as per curriculum in accordance with regulations of University/Board.

In the event of an unavoidable cause or an emergency, a student may apply for leave in writing to the concerned tutor who may in his/ her discretion grant the same if found necessary. In case of an illness, a written record/ Medical Certificate from a staff doctor of the Hospital should be furnished along with the application.

In case of leave requirement for more than 2 days, a letter from the parent will be required for sanction.

Students will report to the tutor in the respective Department at 8 am without fail on the first day of commencement of the course.

D. Fees and Payment

Tuition/Hostel fees are processed through Business office in BBH through Demand drafts/NEFT drawn in favor of BANGALORE BAPTIST HOSPITAL. Mess fees have to be paid in the canteen in advance before 5th of every month and receipts should be retained by the candidate. A copy of the receipt should be submitted to the ALHS office secretary. All fees are subject to change.
