Courses Offered

A) College of Nursing (B Sc Nursing)

The College of Nursing came into existence in the year 2011 and offers 4 years programme and is recognized by Karnataka Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council & affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka and is recognized by. The BBH reserves only 12 seats for B. Sc Nursing. Selection will be on merit basis. For further details please contact college office. And remaining 48 seats will be through KEA.

B) Rebekah Ann Naylor School of Nursing (General Nursing Midwifery Programme)

Rebekah Ann Naylor School of Nursing was established in 1996 to accomplish the training objectives of the hospital and is named after a pioneer missionary. The school offers 3 years Diploma programme in General Nursing and Midwifery which is recognized by Karnataka Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council and is affiliated to the Board of Nursing Education South India Board (Christian Medical Association of India). There are 30 seats in which all are Institutional seat.

Objectives

One of the objectives of the programme is focused towards young women specifically from the economically challenged segment of society in order to provide an opportunity for a career and a noble profession. The institution takes care of the accommodation and offers an assured employment and scope for better opportunities to our graduates. Having graduated more than 500 students so far, the school aspires to continue to accomplish its mission and is striving to carry it forward to transform the lives of young women.

Eligibility Requirements

General Nursing and Midwifery Programme

Duration: Three years

Admission is open to all candidates who fulfill the following criteria:

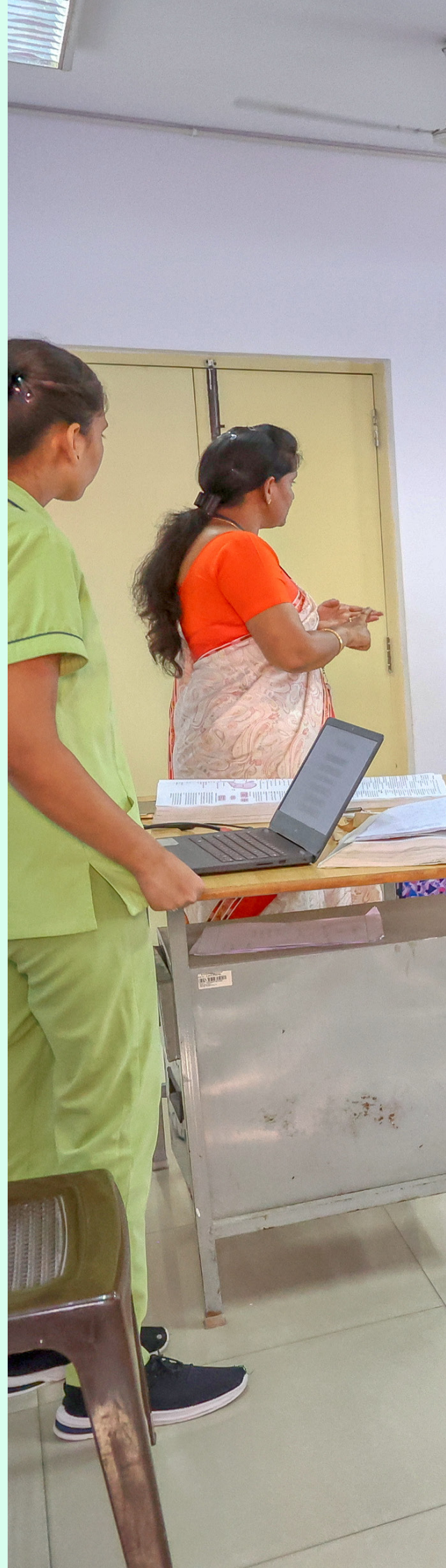
1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years as on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.
2. Minimum education:
 - a. 10+2 class passed preferably Science (PCB) & English with aggregate of 40% marks OR
 - b. 10+2 in Arts (Mathematics, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy) and English Core/English Elective or Health care Science - Vocational stream ONLY, passing out from recognized Board under AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/ SSCE/HSCE or other equivalent Board with 40% marks. OR
 - c. 10+2 vocational ANM under CBSE Board or other equivalent Board from the School and recognized by Indian Nursing Council with 40% marks. OR
 - d. Registered as ANM with State Nursing Registration Council. OR
 - e. Students qualified in 10+2 Arts or Science examination or Health care Science - Vocational stream ONLY conducted by National Institute of Open School with 40% marks.
3. Ability to read, write and speak English since the medium of instruction is English
4. Student shall be medically fit.

Basic B.Sc nursing Programme:

Duration: Four years

Admission is open to all candidates who fulfill the following criteria:

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years as on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.
2. Minimum Educational Qualification
 - a. Candidate with Science who have passed the qualifying 12th Standard examination (10+2) and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together and passed in English individually.
 - b. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science subjects and English only.
 - c. English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc. (Nursing).
3. Colour blind candidates are eligible provided that colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
4. Candidate shall be medically fit.
5. Married candidates are also eligible for admission.





Application Procedure

Medical Fitness

Admission confirmation for both programmes is subject to a medical fitness certificate from Bangalore Baptist Hospital only.

Method of Selection

1. A written examination will be conducted to test the candidate's knowledge in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English, General Knowledge and logical thinking
2. Short listed candidates will be called for an interview on the following day
3. Candidates will be selected based on merit
4. The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final, Unsolicited correspondence is not permitted.
5. Candidates need to bring hardcopy of 12th result on the day of Entrance

Entrance Examination & Interview

Basic B.Sc Nursing

The written entrance examination for (2 hours) will be starting at 9.00 am Tuesday 2nd June 2026. The short listed candidates will be interviewed on 4th June 2026.

General Nursing and Midwifery

The written entrance examination for (2hours) will be starting at 9.00 am Tuesday 2nd June 2026. The shortlisted candidates will be interviewed on 5th June 2026.

Note: Must produce all original certificates during the time of interview otherwise admission may be deferred.

Candidates must be prepared to pay the fees to secure the admission soon after the selection list is published.

Admission

General Nursing and Midwifery:

Selected candidates are required to report to the Nursing Institute at 8:30 AM on Monday, 3rd August 2026, with their original documents (10th and 12th mark cards, and 12th transfer certificate).

Basic B.Sc Nursing:

Selected candidates are required to report to the Nursing Institute at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, 10th August 2026, with their original documents (10th and 12th mark cards, and 12th transfer certificate).

NRI students and students from states other than Karnataka are required to produce an Eligibility Certificate issued by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS), Karnataka, at the time of admission. Failure to submit the Eligibility Certificate on the day of admission will result in cancellation of the allotted seat.

NRI students must contact the Nursing Institute office at 080-2202-4399 prior to applying for the Eligibility Certificate.

The selected candidates must confirm their admission by paying full academic fees (non refundable); If not candidates on waiting list will be called.

Fees & Payment

All money transaction will be through business office in the hospital. Any drafts/ Cheques should be drawn in favour of "Bangalore Baptist Hospital". Mess fees must be paid by cash to the canteen before 5th of every month. Receipts should be kept safely and must be produced whenever necessary. All fees are subject to change.

- Fees must be paid on the day of admission.
- Thereafter, fees should be paid annually at the beginning of each academic year.

NOTE:

- No cash payment will be accepted.
- Payments need to be done only through Demand Draft (DD), online Transfer, NEFT, RTGS or Cheque.
- Demand Draft and Cheque should be in favour of Bangalore Baptist Hospital only

Health Check-up

Students will undergo a complete health check-up after admission and every year thereafter. It is essential that nursing students should be immunized against Hepatitis B. Certain medical conditions which would interfere with successful completion of the course may result in rejection of admission/ discontinuation of the course. This will be at the discretion of the selection committee / administrative committee.

Vaccination:

- Selected candidates are requested to complete their Hepatitis B vaccination before admission



Dress code

The uniforms will be provided by the Institution. Students are not permitted to wear any form of jewellery when they are in uniform. Small ear studs are permitted. Students are expected to be modestly dressed

Attendance

Students are expected to be regular and punctual for classes, clinical duty and field posting. Unauthorized leave and absenteeism is not permitted.

Academic & Clinical Evaluation

All students are expected to maintain high standards of academic and clinical performance. Regular unit tests and clinical evaluation will be conducted to assess the performance of each student. Repeated poor performance may result in delay in promotion or dismissal from the programme, as per the decision of the evaluation committee.

Internal Assessment

Marks scored in unit tests, midterm examination, model examination and practical examination will be considered for the internal assessment.





External Assessment

Board/University examinations are conducted at the end of every academic year/ Semester. Only those students who have passed in the internal examination and who have attendance percentage as prescribed by the board/ University will be eligible to appear for Board/ University examinations.

Leave

Vacation will be given as per the curriculum in accordance with the regulations of the University/Board. Students may be given sick leave not more than 10 days, only if recommended by the doctor. Leave for social events and functions in the family will not be granted.

Accommodation & Board

Students will be provided accommodation within the hostel premises. Canteen is also available in the premises. Hostel warden will be taking care of students in the hostel

Value Education

Students have various avenues for personality development. Common prayer is conducted every evening. A common chapel service is there for the entire staff and students on every Friday. Moral study and value education sessions are conducted weekly. Student's retreats are conducted on a regular basis.



Students Counselling Services

Each student will be assigned a mentor who will meet with them periodically and be available to provide guidance and support. Professional counselling services will be offered to students in need. In addition, a School Counsellor is also available for assistance.

Student Nurses Association

All students are encouraged to become active members of the Students Nurses Association (S.N.A) and Alumni Association of Bangalore Baptist Hospital.

Withdrawal or Discontinuation

If a student withdraws from the course within fifteen days of the date of admission, one-third of the total amount paid at the time of admission will be forfeited.

Students who want to withdraw voluntarily after 15 days of commencement of the class shall be required to pay full fees for the year.

A student who is dismissed/terminated due to unsatisfactory conduct or poor performance in studies will not be eligible for any refund.

The institute reserves the right to dismiss anyone whose performance or conduct is not found satisfactory during the period of training.

Anti Ragging

Ragging is an offence. Any student found to be involved in ragging will be terminated from the course.

Extra Curricular Activities

Students have wide opportunities to participate in social and community affairs organized by the organization. Daily newspapers are made available. Students are allowed to watch TV on weekend. Facilities are provided for various games and sports. Competitions are held in sports, games, cultural, essay writing, quiz, poster making, rangoli, fashion show, flower decoration, hairstyling etc.

Visiting Time and Weekends

Visitors are allowed only on Saturday and Sunday from 1.00 pm - 6.00 pm

Students are allowed to go home only for two weekends in a month with prior written permission taken by the parents from the principal.
