FELLOWSHIP IN- NON-INVASIVE CARDIOLOGY

(Recognized by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences)

1. **Objective:**
To provide an intense, structured training program for Post MD/DNB (General Medicine) candidates, so as to enhance knowledge in all aspect of the Non-Invasive Cardiology.
2. **Duration of Course:**
18 months (full time work as per RGUHS guidelines and not permitted to work elsewhere)
3. **Eligibility:**
 - 1) MD/DNB – in General Medicine
 - 2) NRI (Foreign) Candidates must have MC registration Certificate confirming equivalent qualification.
4. **Selection:**
 - 1) Candidates will be selected by a 4 member panel (Approved by RGUHS).

The cardiology department of BBH provides a state of the art, comprehensive cardiac care that includes DAILY OUTPATIENT SERVICES by prior appointments as well as walk-in services.

In addition we provide the following services

INVASIVE (Procedures performed in cardiac catheter lab)

- Coronary angiogram
- Coronary angioplasty with stent insertion
- Permanent pacemaker implantation
- AICD and CRT device implantation (complex pacing devices)
- Cardiac Electrophysiology studies and Ablation (EPS and Ablation)
- Temporary pacemaker implantation
- Renal artery angioplasty and stent insertion
- Celiac artery angioplasty and stent insertion
- Peripheral vascular angioplasty and stent insertion
- Device closure of ASD, VSD, PDA (hole in the heart)
- Carotid artery stent insertion to prevent strokes

NON-INVASIVE

- 2D echocardiography
- 3D echocardiography
- Trans-esophageal echocardiography (TEE)
- Exercise Treadmill Test (TMT)
- 24 hours Holter Monitoring
- 7 days continuous ECG monitoring (Event recorder)
- Head-up tilt testing (HUTT)

CARDIAC SURGERY

All forms of open heart surgery performed

- a) Coronary artery bypass graft surgery (CABG- Heart Bypass)
- b) Heart valve replacement surgery
- c) Surgical closure of ASD, VSD, PDA (Hole in the heart)
- d) Surgical correction of congenital heart diseases

CARDIAC REHABILITATION

- a) Focused rehab program for patients with all forms of heart ailment
- b) De-addiction and smoking cessation program.

INPATIENT CARE IN CCU

- a) Management of ACS (Acute coronary syndrome- Heart Attack)
- b) Management of Arrhythmias
- c) Management of Heart Failure
- d) Pre and Post op care for patients undergoing open heart surgery
- e) Management of other cardio-vascular emergencies such as hypertensive emergency (very high BP), Pulmonary embolism (blood clot in lungs) etc.
